### Safety

MGGOA has new signs on the 300 yard range and the 100 yard pistol / rifle range to let all shooters know when someone is down range. These signs are stored about 30 yards downrange on the ground next to the pipe to insert them into. The procedure to use these signs is to put the sign in the pvc pipe buried in the ground about 30 yards out from bench # 15. When this sign is in the pvc, all shooters should cease fire and know that someone is down range. They could be checking targets, working behind the berms, etc....so make sure you do not shoot or load guns while this sign is displayed in the pvc pipe. Also make sure you put the sign in the pvc pipe before you go down range for any reason. Please ensure that you and all others in your presence are using this sign properly as a safety precaution. This could very well save someone's life.
